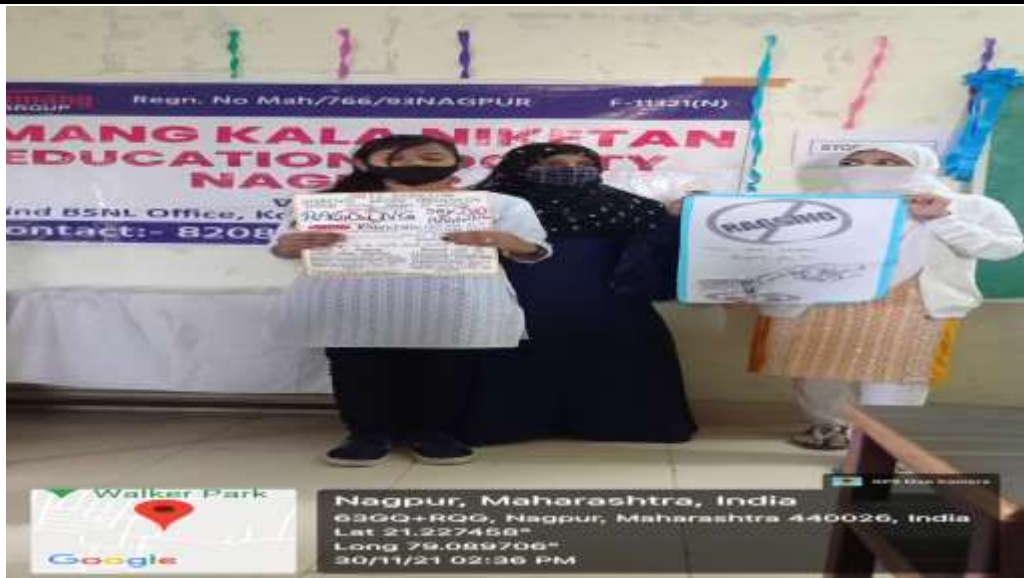

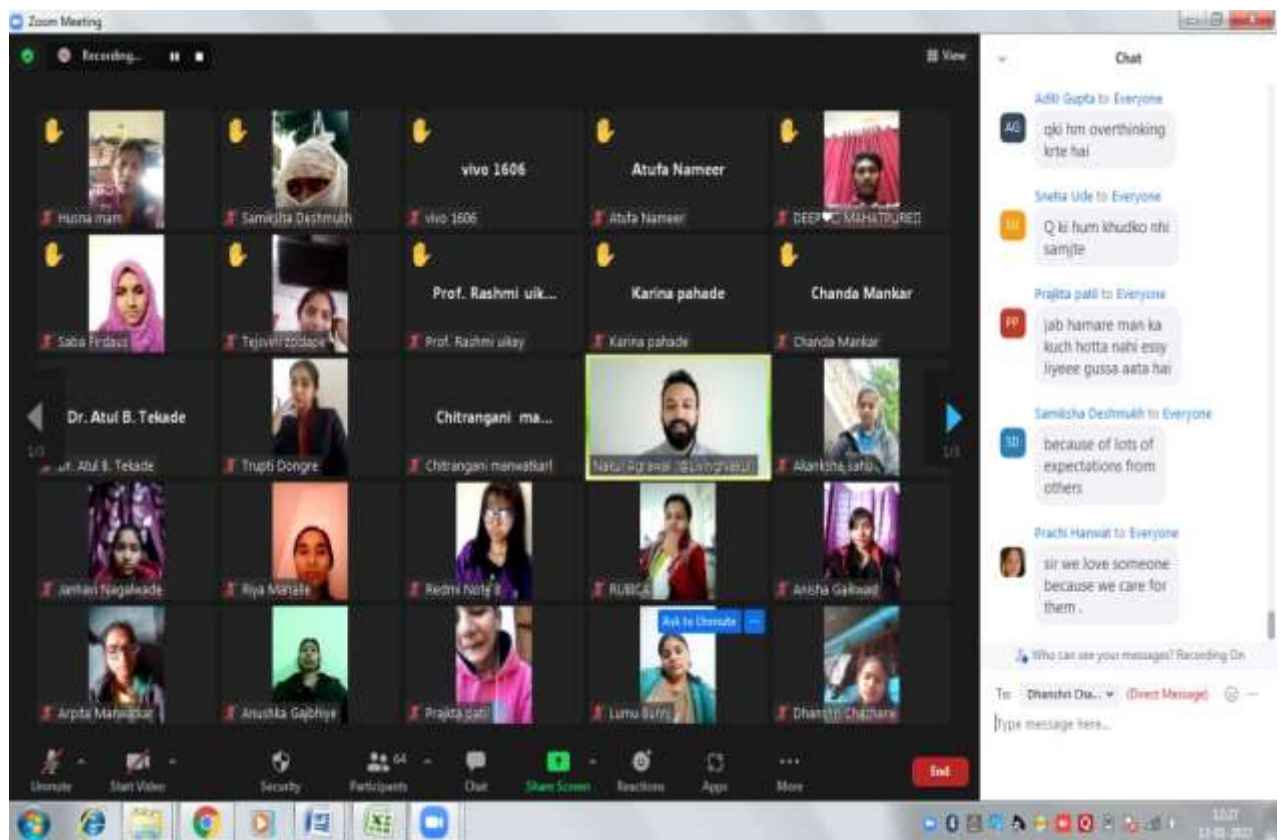

Description of activity:

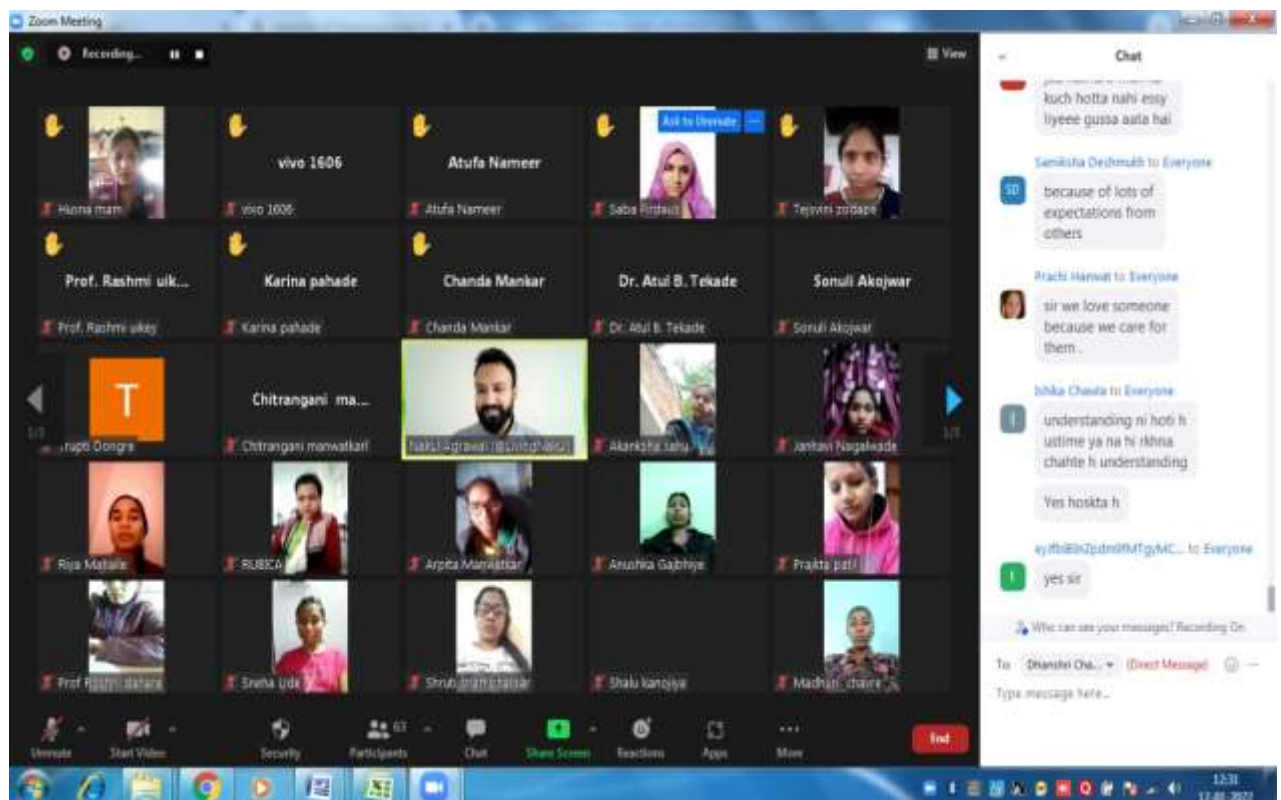

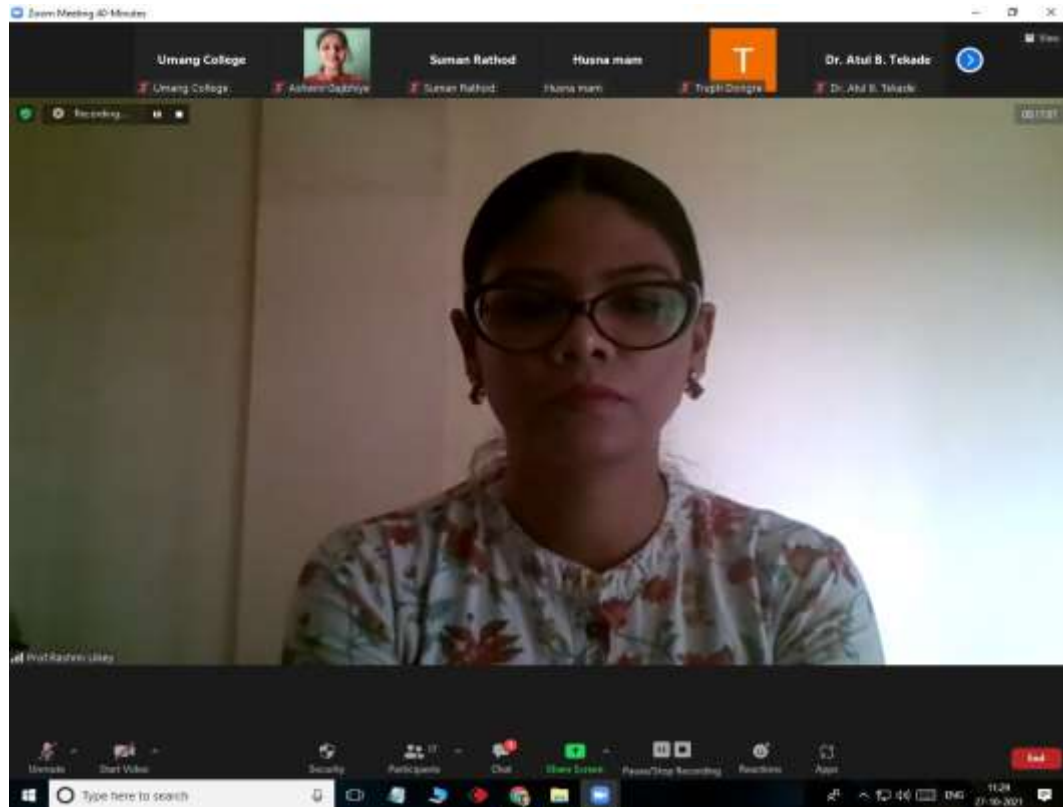
5) Description of activity:
